Junior Choir Tour to Soest in Holland 2014

Dear Parents/Carers

This letter is to give you the dates for the 2014 Junior Choir tour. We are looking to travel to Soest in Holland on Friday 23rd May 2014 departing at around 4:00am. We will be arrive back at school on Monday 26th May at around 11:00pm

If your child would like to come on tour then they must attend rehearsals. We fully understand if you feel they cannot commit to these rehearsals, but you must also understand that we cannot then consider them for the tour.

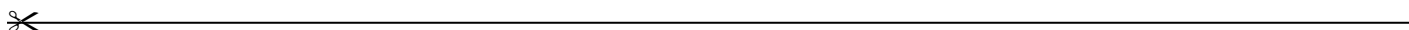
The cost will be in the region of £330 for 4 days/3 nights based on between 40-45 students coming. I can only confirm the final cost once we know how many students will be going. The trip will include **half Board** accommodation (bed, buffet breakfast, and evening meal), hire of an executive coach, travel via Ferry from Dover, as well as rehearsals and concerts. The cost will also include all excursions, but students will need money for lunch, food for travel days and purchasing any souvenirs. I suggest that students bring around 20 Euros a day.

Please return the slip below to the **school finance office** with a **non-refundable** deposit of £75 as soon as possible, but **no later than Thursday 26th September** if you would like to be considered for the tour. You will not be chased for these slips and we will assume a nil return is a 'no'. I will write again to confirm the price of the tour and if the cost is **significantly** more I will offer students their deposits back.

Parents/Carers who are in receipt of income support or family credit who anticipate difficulties with paying for the trip should contact me as soon as possible.
